



ORDER

Issued: March 20, 2002 ; Released: March 22, 2002

Under consideration is a Joint Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice, filed on March 19, 2002, by New York Pay Phone Systems, Inc. ("NYPay"), and Verizon New York Inc. ("Verizon"). This pleading relates to the complaint associated with File No. E-93-59.

NYPay and Verizon state that they have reached a full and complete agreement resolving the litigation relating to the formal complaint associated with File No. E-93-59. They request, therefore, the dismissal of that complaint.

Good cause having been shown, the Joint Motion will be granted and the formal complaint associated with File No. E-93-59 will be dismissed. In addition, with the dismissal of this complaint there remain no outstanding issues which require resolution at a hearing. Consequently, all pending procedural dates will be cancelled and this proceeding will be terminated.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice filed by NYPay and Verizon on March 19, 2002, IS GRANTED, and the complaint associated with File No. E-93-59 IS DISMISSED with prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the procedural dates established in *Memorandum Opinion and Order*, FCC 02M-14, released February 21, 2002, ARE CANCELLED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
