On March 25, 2002, David Gabel and I, on behalf of NASUCA, met with Dorothy Attwood, Jane Jackson, Jack Zinmann, Jay Atkinson and Rich Learner of the FCC Staff to discuss issues raised by the Reply Comments in the above dockets. These issues included policy reasons for the adoption for the originals CALLS order; the need to establish the Subscriber Line Charge based on economic costs; the problems and deficiencies of cost studies filed by the ILECS; the reasons for not using a CMT revenue requirements approach; the use of the Synthesis Model; adjustments made to the Synthesis Model by NASUCA; the use of UNE cost estimates; the use of the Ad Hoc estimates; responses to criticisms of the UNE cost estimates and the use of the Synthesis Model; a discussion of the cost issues relating to feeder fiber and digital line carrier issues raised by NASUCA and the proper treatment of the high frequency portion of the loop.
