PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Wheeler Broadcasting, Inc. ("Petitioner"), the licensee of Station KZLN-FM, Othello, Washington ("Station"), by its attorneys and pursuant to Section 1.420(i) of the Commission's Rules, hereby petitions the Commission for amendment of the Commission's FM Table of Allotments, in Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, to substitute Channel 248C2 for Channel 248C3 at Othello, Washington, to reallocate Channel 248C2 from Othello to Basin City, Washington, and to modify the license of the Station to specify operation Channel 248C2 at Basin City. In support hereof, Petitioner states as follows:

A. Technical Compliance

1. As the attached Engineering Statement (Exhibit 1 hereto) ("Engineering Statement") demonstrates, the proposed changes in the FM allotments fully comply with the Commission's technical requirements. The proposal comports with the Commission's spacing rules for FM allotments, provides 70 dBu coverage to all of Basin City, and is mutually exclusive with the present Channel 248 C3 allotment. Six stations would continue to provide service to the

entire loss area created by the reallocation, with several additional stations serving portions of the loss area.

2. The proposed allotment is a preferential arrangement under the Commission's FM priorities¹ and, thus, better serves the public interest than the existing allotment. The proposal would provide Basin City with its first local transmission service without depriving Othello of local transmission service.² Through the proposed facilities upgrade and reallocation, the Station would offer enhanced service to an expanded listening base. Under the proposed allotment, a total of 155,954 persons would receive an additional aural service, 532 currently underserved persons would receive additional aural service, and nine of these underserved persons would receive their second service. Further, the reallocation would not create any white, gray, or underserved areas.

B. Community of License

3. Petitioners seeking to change community of license pursuant to Section 1.420(i) of the Commission's Rules must propose a channel that is mutually exclusive with the existing channel, and the new community must be preferred over the existing community under the Commission's allotment priorities. *See Amendment of the Commission's Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License*, 4 FCC Rcd 4870 (1989), *recons. granted in part*, 5 FCC Rcd 7094 (1990). The proposed reallocation satisfies these threshold requirements.

¹ The Commission's FM priorities, as set forth in the *Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures*, 90 FCC 2d 88, 91-92 (1982) ("*FM Assignment Policies*"), include: (1) first aural service; (2) second aural service; (3) first local service; and (4) other public interest matters. The Commission gives co-equal weight to priorities (2) and (3). *Id.*

² Othello would retain local service from Station KRSC(AM), which provides daytime 5 mV/m and nighttime interference-free service to 100% of Othello.

4. First, the allotment proposed hereby is mutually exclusive with the present allotment. As the Engineering Statement demonstrates, the distance between the proposed and existing allotment sites is 14.54 km, well short of the 177 km minimum distance separation requirement for co-channel class C2 and C3 facilities set forth in Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules. 47 C.F.R. § 73.207(b)(1). Second, the proposal results in a preferential arrangement under the Commission's FM priorities. The proposed reallocation provides Basin City with its first local transmission service without depriving Othello of local transmission service. As evidenced by the Engineering Statement, the proposal would result in a small loss area of 38 km² and a 2000 Census population of 249 persons, while providing for a gain area of 3,799 km² and a 2000 Census population of 155,954 persons.


5. Basin City satisfies the Commission's definition of "community" for allotment purposes. *See Report and Order, In the Matter of Amendment of Section 73.202(b), Table of Allotments, FM Broadcast Stations (Elkhorn City and Coal Run, Kentucky)*, 16 FCC Rcd 15268 (M.M.B. 2001); *Report and Order, In the Matter of Amendment of Section 73.202(b), Table of Allotments, FM Broadcast Stations (Cobleskill and Saint Johnsville, New York)*, 16 FCC Rcd 6966 (M.M.B. 2001). As evidenced by the data attached hereto as Exhibit 2, Basin City is a Census-designated place with a 2000 Census population of 968 persons. A number of churches, restaurants, grocery stores and other businesses are located in Basin City, including establishments incorporating "Basin City" in their names, e.g., Basin City Baptist Church, Basin City Market, Basin City Ambulance. Basin City is also home to its own Basin City Airfield, a volunteer fire department, Basin City Health Services, Basin City Elementary School, as well as a public library.

6. Basin City is neither located within the Richland-Kennewick-Pasco Urbanized Area, nor would the proposed city-grade signal cover more than 50 percent of that Urbanized Area. Accordingly, it is not necessary to undertake an analysis of Basin City's independence as a community pursuant to *Faye and Richard Tuck*, 3 FCC Rcd 5374 (1988).

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Wheeler Broadcasting, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Petition for Rule Making, amend Section 73.202(b) to substitute Channel 248C2 for Channel 248C3 at Othello, Washington, reallocate Channel 248C2 from Othello to Basin City, Washington, and modify the authorization for Station KZLN-FM accordingly.

Engineering Statement

This Engineering Statement has been prepared on behalf of Wheeler Broadcasting, Inc. ("Wheeler"), licensee of station KZLN 248C3 at Othello, Washington, in support of a Petition for Rulemaking to amend §73.202 of the Commission's Rules to substitute Channel 248C2 for Channel 248C3 at Othello, Washington, reallocate Channel 248C2 to Basin City, Washington, and modify the license of station KZLN to specify operation on the upgraded channel at Basin City.

The proposed reallocation plan will provide several benefits:

- 1) KZLN will be able to upgrade to Class C2, and thus will be able to provide enhanced service to a broader listening area.
- 2) Basin City, a Census Designated Place with a 2000 Census population of 968 persons, will receive its first local service.
- 3) A total of 155,954 persons will receive an additional aural service.
- 4) A total of 532 presently underserved persons will receive an additional aural service, of which 9 persons will receive their second service.
- 5) In accommodating the benefits listed above, no white, gray, or underserved areas will be created.

Channel 248C2 at Basin City

As outlined in the attached channel study, Channel 248C2 can be assigned for use at Basin City in compliance with the Commission's applicable Rules and Regulations regarding the

separation among FM allotments. For this study the coordinates of a hilltop site (NL 46° 39' 26" x WL 119° 10' 23") have been used. This site is 7 kilometers from Basin City, the coordinates of which are NL 46° 35' 39" x WL 119° 09' 04". The nominal distance to the 70 dBu F(50,50) contour for a Class C2 station is 32.6 kilometers. Therefore, this site will provide greater than 70 dBu coverage for all of Basin City.

Othello will retain local service from station KRSC 1400 kHz, which provides daytime 5 mV/m and nighttime interference-free service to 100% of Othello.

Gain and Loss Areas

The 60 dBu contour of Channel 248C2 at Basin City nearly encompasses the 60 dBu contour of the present Channel 248C3 operation at Othello. Therefore, there will be only a small loss area directly associated with that upgrade, encompassing 38 km² and a 2000 Census population of 249 persons. The gain area directly associated with the upgrade at Basin City encompasses 3,799 km² and a 2000 Census population of 155,954 persons.

The proposed reallocation plan will not result in the creation of any white, gray, or underserved areas. Each of the following stations provides 60 dBu service to 100% of the loss area¹:

Much of the gain area associated with this proposal is considered to be well-served. However, grant of the proposal will provide additional service to an underserved area encompassing 835 km² and a 2000 Census population of 532 persons, including 9 persons who will receive their second aural service.

¹In determining reception service provided by FM stations, the area of service circumscribed by the station's 1.0 mV/m signal contour was considered, assuming 1) actual facilities for non-commercial stations operating on reserved channels, 2) maximum facilities for the class of station for stations (other than Class C stations) operating on non-reserved channels, and 3) minimum or existing Class C facilities, whichever is greater, for Class C stations. For clear channel Class A AM stations, the service area was defined by the station's 0.5 mV/m groundwave contour, based on its licensed facilities. For all other classes of full-time AM stations, reception service was defined as that service received within a station's nighttime interference-free contour.

Based upon these circumstances, no "Tuck" analysis is believed to be required in support of the proposed reallocation plan.




**Gain and Loss Areas
Map Layers**


