ERRATUM AND SUPPLEMENT TO PETITION FOR RULEMAKING


Mountain States Radio, Inc. ("MSR") the licensee of broadcast station KZCY(FM) in Cheyenne, Wyoming, filed a Petition for Rulemaking on February 22, 2002. MSR requested that KZCY(FM) be upgraded from its current Channel 285A to Channel 280C1. In order to accommodate the channel change, MSR also requested that Channel 285C2 be substituted for vacant and unapplied for Channel 280C2 in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

References in the last two lines of the Petition for Rulemaking erroneously refer to Channel 280C2 on two occasions. The references in the last two lines of the Petition should be corrected to refer to Channel 280C1.

MSR submits its Petition for Rulemaking on the express condition that in the event there is an expression of interest for Channel 280C1 and it is determined there is no comparable channel, that MSR can withdraw its Petition for Rulemaking without jeopardizing its current operation on Channel 285A. The Commission's *Modification of FM and TV licenses* 98 FCC 2d 916, ¶9 allows a petitioner to withdraw a rulemaking proposal where the existing and proposed allotments are incompatible.


