





Dear Ms. Edmundson:

This is in response to the April 3, 2002, request to withdraw the petition for rulemaking, which you submitted on behalf of Blue Sky Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of FM Station KPND, Channel 237C1, Sandpoint, Idaho, seeking the substitution of Channel 237C for Channel 237C1 at Sandpoint, and modification of the license for Station KPND accordingly. Additionally, to accommodate the Sandpoint modification, the petition for rulemaking requested the substitution of Channel 236C3 for Channel 237C3 at Orofino, Idaho, and modification of the license of Station KLER-FM accordingly.

The issuance of a Notice of Proposed Rule Making setting forth the requested amendments to the FM Table of Allotments at Sandpoint and Orofino, Idaho, has been held in abeyance, at your request, pending the filing of Section 73.3517 coordinated change applications to accomplish the one-step upgrade of Station KPND at Sandpoint and the modification of KLER-FM at Orofino.

You advise that on March 6, 2002, an application to modify the facilities of Station KPND (File No. BPH-20020318AAO) as well as an application to modify Station KLER-FM (File No. BPH-20020318AAM) were filed with the Commission. Accordingly, as those facility changes are now being pursued through the application process, you have requested withdrawal of the rulemaking proposal without prejudice.

In consideration of the foregoing, and in accordance with Commission policy, we herewith grant the petitioner's request to withdraw its rulemaking proposal, without prejudice.
