

Representatives of the Community Broadcasters Association ("CBA") called Mr. Ferree's attention to the pending petition for rule making and urged him to advance the proceeding promptly to a Notice of Proposed Rule Making. CBA also reiterated some of the points made in its written supporting comments, including the fact that the proposal respects the marketplace by honoring private contracts and would remove an existing inequity between full power and Class A television stations that are carrying the same network programming.
