

Dear Secretary,

I am writing in support of RM-10077 Modification of Section 90.20 c of the Commission's Rules to Permit Use of Any Certified Public Safety Frequency Coordinator for Channels below 470 MHz.

I have served in Public Safety Communications for 36 years. During those years, I have often found it difficult to obtain a radio channel or channels due to the fact that frequently, many different Coordinators would have to be consulted. This process would be greatly simplified if any of the four Public Safety Coordinators (APCO, IMSA, AASHTO and FCCA) would be permitted to coordinate all Public Safety channels below 470 MHz. This would create a "one stop" process for the end users.
