On Tuesday, April 30, 2002, Lynn Gunwall, Vice President of Penasco Valley Telephone in Artesia, NM; John Prendergast from the law firm Blooston, Mordkofsky, Dickens, Duffy & Prendergast; and Jill Canfield, Regulatory Counsel of the National Telecommunications Cooperative Association met with Sam Feder, Legal Advisor on Spectrum and International Issues to Commissioner Martin. We discussed the postponement of the lower 700 MHz auction, currently scheduled to begin June 19, 2002.

Specifically, the group expressed its opposition to the Cellular Telecommunications & Internet Association's (CTIA) Application for Review of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's denial of CTIA's request to postpone the auction. The group discussed how the Commission will best fulfill its Congressional mandates if it proceeds with the auction as scheduled.
