On May 1, 2002, on behalf of ICO Global Communications (Holdings) Ltd., Craig McCaw, Gerry Salemme, and the undersigned met with Commissioner Kevin Martin and Sam Feder, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Martin. During the meeting ICO emphasized the need for expeditious action in the MSS flexibility proceeding in order to proceed apace with ICO system upgrades, and highlighted the critical role of MSS in delivery of broadband services, particularly in rural and unserved areas. ICO also stressed that MSS would be rendered infeasible if independent terrestrial providers are allowed to operate in MSS spectrum.
