PETITION FOR RULE MAKING (Frisco City, AL)

Now comes MissAla RF before the Policy and Rules Division to petition for the allocation of a new FM radio channel at Frisco City, Alabama on channel 278A. Only one change to an existing station is required to place channel 278A at Frisco City other than a trigger of WUSW Hattiesburg, MS on channel 279C. According to the CDBS, WUSW is operating with an antenna height of 322 meters instead of 451(+) meters, and as of January 18, 2002 did not have an application on file to maintain a class "C" designation. MissAla RF has obtained consent from the licensee of WYOK, channel 281C Atmore, Alabama to have its reference coordinates modified since a relocation of the antenna is being conducted anyway.

Therefore, MissAla request the FCC issue a notice to the licensee of WUSW that it be triggered to class C0 immediately and that channel 278A be put at Frisco City as a result of that trigger.

Petitioner's Exhibit A shows that channel 278A can be placed at Frisco City without creating short spacing once WUSW is triggered to class C0. It also shows WYOK at the site consented to by the licensee. Petitioner's Exhibit B is a 'TIGER' map with a 16.2-kilometer circle representing 70 DBU. It shows that this new channel gives city grade strength to Frisco City. Petitioner's Exhibit C shows that WYOK can move to the site agreed to by the licensee and not have short spacing. Petitioner's Exhibit D is a 'TIGER'

map showing a 67.7-kilometer DBU circle. It shows city grade strength to Atmore, Alabama.

MissAla RF will file an application for a CP to own and operate a new FM station of channel 278A at Frisco City, AL after the FCC puts the new channel there.

MissAla RF has attached a proper signature page and verification to the petition for rule making.

Based on the data given to MissAla RF, the FAA will not allow a tower high enough to give WUSW an antenna of 451 meters. So, the licensee should have no problem with the C0 trigger.

There is another parallel petition for rule making in Mississippi that can be allocated at Flora on channel 280A if WUSW is classed at a C0. Two new local services can be created with the WUSW C0 classification. This appears to be high public interest matters. MissAla RF request that the FCC act quickly and positively on the petition since high public interest concerns are at stake.


