

In order to stimulate the proliferation of Broadband, rely as much as possible on free market forces.

Don't gerrymander the environment with self fulfilling failures, like the deregulation that created CLECs has generally been. The fatal flaw was in trying to give CLECs the use of their strongest competitors' assets in UNEs. This not only makes CLECs dependent on their strongest competitors but makes them more dependent on the ILECs as they don't need to build to go into business.

Stimulate the ILECs by giving them the freedom to plan and deploy their business assets safe from fear that they will have the use of their assets confiscated for the good of their competitors, a practice which I believe to actually unconstitutional.

Couple lifting the burden on from ILECs with a move that stimulates Broadband terrestrial wireless and Broadband via satellite.

In the end, 3 or 4 Facilities based competitors in any market will be more than enough.
