On Thursday, April 25th, 2002, Peter Rohrbach of Hogan & Hartson and the undersigned representing Qwest Communications Corporation, met in separate meetings with Daniel Gonzalez in Commissioner's Kevin J. Martin's Office and Jordan Goldstein in Commissioner Michael J. Copps office. The purpose of the meetings was to discuss Qwest's positions that (1) IDT Winstar was required to assume interconnection agreements and service contracts between Qwest and Old Winstar to step into and receive the benefits of those agreements; and (2) IDT Winstar should have been required to give appropriate notice to end users in advance of the last date to assume or reject contracts in Old Winstar's bankruptcy case.
