SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE

Communications Capital Company II of Louisiana, LLC ("CCC"), licensee of FM Broadcast Station KNBB (FM), Channel 257C3, Ruston, Louisiana, by its attorneys and pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's Rules, hereby submits its supplemental notice in the above-captioned rule making proceedings. In support thereof, the following is set forth.

1. On March 19, 2001, Ruston Broadcasting Company, Inc. ("RBC"), former licensee of KNBB, Ruston, Louisiana, timely filed its comments and counterproposal requesting that Section 73.202 (b) of the Commission's Rules, the FM Table of Allotments, be amended to: substitute Channel 257C2 for Channel 257C3 at Ruston, Louisiana, for use by KNBB; delete vacant Channel 257A at Clayton, Louisiana, and assign Channel 266A for use at Clayton; allot Channel 300C3 at Saint Joseph, Louisiana,

rather than Channel 257C3 as proposed by Saint Joseph Broadcasting Company in MM Docket No. 01-19; and allot Channel 279A at Wisner, Louisiana, rather than Channel 300C3 as proposed by Wisner Broadcasting Company in MM Docket No. 01-27. RBC stated that if its counterproposal was adopted, it would (a) apply for the upgraded channel in Ruston and, upon grant of the minor change upgrade application, promptly construct the station, and (b), in the case of the Saint Joseph and Wisner allocations, apply for the channels and, if authorized, promptly construct the stations.


2. On March 4, 2002, Communications Capital Managers, LLC (“CCM”) consummated the acquisition of KNBB from RCB pursuant to Commission consent, granted on September 28, 2001, in Application File No. BALH-20010806ABH. On March 4, 2002, CCM filed a short form application (File No. BALH-20020304ACW) to assign the license of KNBB to CCC; that pro forma assignment was granted on May 1, 2002, and consummated on May 2, 2002. Should Channel 257C2 be substituted for channel 257C3 at Ruston, Louisiana, for use by KNBB, CCC, as the current licensee of KNBB, will promptly file a minor change application to implement such upgrade and construct the modified facilities.

3. RBC’s commitment to apply for and, if authorized, construct the Saint Joseph and Wisner stations continues unchanged. In this regard, at Section 20.12 of the Asset Purchase Agreement, dated July 30, 2001, between RBC and CCM, a copy of which is on file with the Commission and which is hereby incorporated by reference, RBC’s covenant not to compete with CCM provided that “Seller [RBC] and Dan Hollingsworth [RBC’s president and sole owner] shall not be precluded from seeking FM allocations in the communities of Wisner and Saint Joseph, Louisiana, as proposed by

Seller in its Comments and Counterproposal in MM Docket Nos. 01-19 (RM-10048) and
01-27 (RM-10056).”


