A Prehearing Conference was held on April 23, 2002. See Order FCC 01M-30, released April 17, 2002. It was agreed that the hearing date would be October 15, 2002.

Counsel shall consult within one week to discuss the scope and schedule of discovery and the number of witnesses expected to testify at the hearing.¹ A Status Report on the meeting shall be submitted by **May 8, 2002**.

The following procedural dates ARE SET:

- September 10, 2002** - Discovery ends.
- October 1, 2002** - Exchange cases and identify witnesses.
- October 8, 2002** - Notify Witnesses for Cross-Examination.
- October 15, 2002** - Hearing to commence at 9:00 a.m.

¹ There are ten (10) specific issues set in the HDO which also notes that the assignment applications are being processed by the Mass Media Bureau and suggests that the Mass Media Bureau "avail itself of the opportunity to have the Enforcement Bureau formally request that the ALJ add any further issues deemed appropriate by its processing staff." See Memorandum Opinion and Order and Hearing Designation Order, FCC 02-91, released March 28, 2002, at Para. 34. Counsel for Family should be informed immediately about any such issues, and any request must comply with the Commission's rule for adding issues. See 47 C.F.R. §1.229.


Documents shall be assembled in a binder with each exhibit bearing a number and tab, and with each exhibit separately paginated. The exhibits shall be serially numbered for identification beginning with the number 1, preceded by a sponsoring party's prefix (e.g. Family Exh. 1; EB Exh. 1).

Stipulations shall be executed by counsel and should be contained in a separate tabbed, paginated binder, and submitted as joint exhibits.

Documents for which Official Notice is requested shall be separately bound, tabbed, paginated and numbered for identification.
