


1. This order grants a Motion for Extension of Time, filed March 21, 2002, by Marc D. Sobel and James A. Kay, Jr. Kay and Sobel seek an extension of time from March 24, 2002 to March 26, 2002 to file replies to oppositions to petitions for reconsideration that they filed in this proceeding.¹ Kay and Sobel indicate that their pleadings had been drafted and were substantially complete when their counsel's computer, on which the drafts were being prepared, malfunctioned. Kay and Sobel state they anticipate that the computer can be expeditiously repaired or the documents salvaged and that the pleadings can be filed within a two-day extension of time. Kay and Sobel represent that counsel for the Enforcement Bureau has consented to the extension.

2. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED, Pursuant to the authority delegated under 47 C.F.R. § 0.251(c), that the Motion for Extension of time, filed March 21, 2002, by Marc D. Sobel and James A. Kay, Jr. IS GRANTED with respect to this proceeding and the

D. Sobel and James A. Kay, Jr. IS GRANTED with respect to this proceeding and the deadline for filing the pleadings in question IS EXTENDED until March 26, 2002.
