

The enclosed modification of the Region 30 Channel Allotment Plan is submitted for FCC acceptance. This modified Channel Allotment Plan is the result of a 3<sup>rd</sup> Application Filing Window.

Inter-regional concurrence was requested of adjacent Public Safety Regions 8, 19, 28, 36, and 55. Delivery of the request for concurrence to all addressees on September 6, 2001 was confirmed. Concurrence has been provided by Region 8 on March 8, 2002, Region 19 on January 30, 2002 and Region 55 on December 10, 2001.

Region 28 has not responded in the intervening 7 months, which we take to mean they have no objection. Region 36 requested an extension of time to reply of January 15, 2002. Since their requested date they have not submitted any further communication, which we take to mean they have no objection.



Paul Schonewolf has forwarded to me a copy of your letter of November 13, 2001 in which you have requested an extension of time within which to respond to our request for inter-regional concurrence, dated August 30, 2001.

While 973 site channel allotments in 30 counties have been approved by Region 30, you should realize that this includes the geographical area from the Pennsylvania border with New York State all the way up to Canada. Clearly, only a portion of those site channel allotments will even come close to Region 36. To further ease your burden, MS PowerPoint graphics were included for each of the site channel allotments to illustrate the 40, 25, and 5 dB $\mu$ V/M contours of the proposed site and the existing FCC licensed co-channel and adjacent channel sites. These contours also show the results of our having applied directional antennas to reduce signal incursion into adjacent regions.

I take issue with the last sentence in the first paragraph of your letter regarding other Regions not having used the "no response within 30 days indicates no objection" clause. In point of fact, Region 28, of which you are a member, used that clause in its requests for inter-regional concurrence for Window 6A, dated May 5, 2000, and attached to their FCC filing, dated August 28, 2000, to amend GN Docket No. 89-57. Also, I note that your response requesting an extension of time was initiated more than 60 days after your receipt of our request for inter-regional concurrence - over twice the requested time.

However, we agree with you that Regional Planning is a voluntary activity, and we will agree to your request for extension of time until January 15, 2002 to receive your comments; and further, we offer you the assistance of the State of New York's consultant, at their expense, if that will facilitate your timely review.


Dear Sir or Madam:

Please accept this letter as our official filing for approval of our Filing Window 6A. Filing Window 6 was divided into two parts (6A & 6B) to expedite the assignment process. Filing window 6A includes those applications whose 5 dBu contour does not leave the boundaries of Region 28. We are still working on Window 6B, which will be filed separately and include those applications whose 5 dBu contours extend beyond the Region 28 boundaries as those assignments will require more time to coordinate with adjacent regions.

Letters requesting concurrence for Window 6A were mailed to all adjacent regions on May 5, 2000 (copies attached) advising them of the conditions of the split filing and requesting their review and concurrence. To date we have only received one response from Region 8 in the affirmative (copy attached). This filing is also in full compliance with the requirements of the inter-regional agreement between Regions 20 and 28 as stipulated in Paragraph 5 (F) of the Inter-Regional Coordination Procedures Agreement, in that Region 20 RPRC had 60 calendar days, from the notification date of May 5, 2000, to respond to this Inter-Regional Coordination request. As the Chairman of Region 20 did not respond in the allotted time, than it shall be assumed that the Region 20 RPRC has given *unconditional concurrence* to this Inter-Regional request and the Window 6A channel assignments.



As chairman of Region 36, I am in receipt of your request for revision of the Region 30 allotment matrix dated August 30, 2001. This is an extensive document with a total of 973 site/channel allotments that must be reviewed by Region 36. As such, our committee takes exception to the closing statement of your August 30, 2000 letter that indicates, "If a response is not received within 30 days, we will assume you do not object to this plan amendment." Region 36 does not agree to this statement, nor have our Regions enacted any inter-Regional agreement to this effect.

The regional planning process is not a full time activity. All committees lack technical and operational support that would permit the evaluation of plan amendments of your scope within the time constraints indicated in your letter. Even with the full support of the New York State Technology Enterprise Corporation, this Region 30 allotment proposal must have taken a very long period to develop. This extensive work deserves a reasonable period of time to review and question the planning document prior to issuing our recommendation. The nature and scope of this amendment would take our volunteer technical committee many months to review. I have authorized funding from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to contract this review to a consultant, in order to speed the process and return a recommendation to your committee by January 15, 2002. This expense is non-reimbursable and is incurred as a planning expense of Region 36. We expect to shortly receive a similar request from Region 55, proposing a similar scale of activity for the State of New York. Proper time must be allotted for this significant workload.

In closing, Region 36 does not concur with the Region 30 amendment plan as presented at this time.

Also, I note that your response requesting an extension of time was initiated more than 60 days after your receipt of our request for inter-regional concurrence - over twice the requested time.

However, we agree with you that Regional Planning is a voluntary activity, and we will agree to your request for extension of time until January 15, 2002 to receive your comments; and further, we offer you the assistance of the State of New York's consultant, at their expense, if that will facilitate your timely review.





Please accept this letter as our official filing for approval of our Filing Window 6A. Filing Window 6 was divided into two parts (6A & 6B) to expedite the assignment process. Filing window 6A includes those applications whose 5 dBu contour does not leave the boundaries of Region 28. We are still working on Window 6B, which will be filed separately and include those applications whose 5 dBu contours extend beyond the Region 28 boundaries as those assignments will require more time to coordinate with adjacent regions.

Letters requesting concurrence for Window 6A were mailed to all adjacent regions on May 5, 2000 (copies attached) advising them of the conditions of the split filing and requesting their review and concurrence. To date we have only received one response from Region 8 in the affirmative (copy attached). This filing is also in full compliance with the requirements of the inter-regional agreement between Regions 20 and 28 as stipulated in Paragraph 5 (F) of the Inter-Regional Coordination Procedures Agreement, in that Region 20 RPRC had 60 calendar days, from the notification date of May 5, 2000, to respond to this Inter-Regional Coordination request. As the Chairman of Region 20 did not respond in the allotted time, than it shall be assumed that the Region 20 RPRC has given *unconditional concurrence* to this Inter-Regional request and the Window 6A channel assignments.

As chairman of Region 36, I am in receipt of your request for revision of the Region 30 allotment matrix dated August 30, 2001. This is an extensive document with a total of 973 site/channel allotments that must be reviewed by Region 36. As such, our committee takes exception to the closing statement of your August 30, 2000 letter that indicates, "If a response is not received within 30 days, we will assume you do not object to this plan amendment." Region 36 does not agree to this statement, nor have our Regions enacted any inter-Regional agreement to this effect.

The regional planning process is not a full time activity. All committees lack technical and operational support that would permit the evaluation of plan amendments of your scope within the time constraints indicated in your letter. Even with the full support of the New York State Technology Enterprise Corporation, this Region 30 allotment proposal must have taken a very long period to develop. This extensive work deserves a reasonable period of time to review and question the planning document prior to issuing our recommendation. The nature and scope of this amendment would take our volunteer technical committee many months to review. I have authorized funding from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to contract this review to a consultant, in order to speed the process and return a recommendation to your committee by January 15, 2002. This expense is non-reimbursable and is incurred as a planning expense of Region 36. We expect to shortly receive a similar request from Region 55, proposing a similar scale of activity for the State of New York. Proper time must be allotted for this significant workload.

In closing, Region 36 does not concur with the Region 30 amendment plan as presented at this time.

On July 11, 2001, the Region 30 Regional Plan Update Committee met at Town Hall, Niskayuna, New York, to consider revision of the Region 30 Plan's table of Channel Allotments and the applications of Saratoga County, New York, and the State of New York Statewide Wireless Network for channel allotments. The attached channel allotment plan and supporting information was approved and is submitted to you for inter-regional concurrence.

It should be noted that very significant channel re-use has resulted from extensive use of low profile sites and directional antenna patterns. Within counties, channel allotments have been re-used 35 times. Within the entire Region 30 area, the channels have been re-used a total of 760 times. A total of 973 site/channel allotments have been made for 213 system operation channels, exclusive of the regionwide, eight (8) low power and four (4) guard channels in the top end of the band, and the five (5) FCC designated mutual aid/interoperability channels.


