Dear Mr. Ohlson:

Pine Belt Cellular, Inc. dba Pine Belt Wireless ("Pine Belt"), through counsel, hereby responds to the Federal Communications Commission's letter dated May 14, 2002 ("Letter") regarding the filing of carrier transition reports for implementation of the 911 abbreviated dialing code.<sup>1</sup> As stated in the Letter and in the Commission's Fifth Report and Order, carriers that do not cover any of the 183 counties listed in Appendix D of the Fifth Report and Order are not required to file a report at this time.<sup>2</sup>

Pine Belt hereby notifies the Commission that the company's licensed service area does not include any of the counties listed on Appendix D of the Fifth Report and Order. Pine Belt is licensed to serve the Phase 2 portion of market CMA309, which does not include any of the counties specified on Appendix D. Accordingly, Pine Belt is not required to file a report at this time.
