**RESPONSE OF
ELGIN FM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP AND CHARLES CRAWFORD
TO "REPLY OF AM & PM BROADCASTERS, LLC"**

1. Elgin FM Limited Partnership and Charles Crawford ("Elgin FM/Crawford") hereby respond to the Reply submitted by AM & PM Broadcasters, LLC ("AM & PM") to Comments submitted in the above-captioned proceeding by Elgin FM/Crawford.

2. AM & PM first claims that Elgin FM/Crawford erroneously attributed ownership of Station KGOK(FM) to AM & PM. This claim is based on the fact that Station KGOK(FM) is owned by AM & PM *Communications*, LLC, as opposed to AM & PM *Broadcasters*, LLC. Elgin FM/Crawford acknowledge that the distinction noted by AM & PM is correct -- but it is a distinction without a difference.

3. Review of the current Ownership Reports for both of the AM & PM entities

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reveals that they share the same majority owner (Richard Witkovsky) and the same minority owners (Ralph Kerr and Ken Mok). See Attachment A (copies of Ownership Reports). So while there may indeed be two separately identifiable business entities for some purposes, in fact they are essentially identical entities, subject to the controlling ownership of the same individual. Because of that, it is not at all clear why AM & PM would even try to suggest that there is any meaningful distinction between the two.^{1/}

4. It is also not clear why this distinction, meaningful or otherwise, is now so important to AM & PM, when AM & PM was not moved to cavil when the Joint Parties failed to perceive the distinction in their Counterproposal filed herein on October 10, 2000.

The Joint Parties stated that

AM & PM Broadcasting, LLC ("AM & PM"), the licensee of KICM and KGOK, has provided a consent statement for the relocation of Station KGOK from Healdton to Purcell.

Joint Parties' Counterproposal at 17, ¶28. So Elgin FM/Crawford are obviously not alone in failing to appreciate the subtleties which AM & PM now claim to be somehow all-important.

5. Acknowledging the purely technical correction concerning the technical identities of the licensees in question, Elgin FM/Crawford stand by their Comments.

^{1/} Indeed, while AM & PM emphasizes that the December, 1998 agreement with the Joint Parties was "not entered into by AM & PM Broadcasters, LLC" and that AM & PM Broadcasters, LLC "was not a company who had been 'in discussions with the Joint Parties as early as December, 1998'", AM & PM Reply at 2 (emphasis in original), it fails to point out that the more-than-one-million-dollar pay-off from that agreement would flow into coffers controlled by precisely the same fellow who controls AM & PM. Since the two AM & PM entities have the same three owners, including the same controlling owner, AM & PM cannot seriously suggest that its owners were unaware of the December, 1998 agreement or were uninvolved in the discussions leading up to it. It is impossible to perceive any meaningful distinction between AM & PM Communications, LLC and AM & PM Broadcasters, LLC in this regard. And, as noted in the text below, even the Joint Parties -- *i.e.*, the folks with whom AM & PM (or its alter ego) was negotiating -- did not perceive any distinction between the two.

6. AM & PM next assails as "preposterous", "unsupported speculation", and "patently ridiculous nonsense" the suggestion, advanced by Elgin FM/Crawford in their Comments, that AM & PM may have had some hint of the Quanah proceeding as a result of the 1998 negotiations leading up to the Healdton/Purcell agreement mentioned above. Given the identity of the principals of the two AM & PM entities, it is clear beyond argument that those principals, having negotiated the December, 1998 deal, knew that some rule making was in the works affecting the Healdton area, and the rule making was of sufficient economic value to warrant a more-than-one-million-dollar commitment just to move the Healdton channel to Purcell. Even a relatively unsophisticated broadcaster could likely have recognized that something was up.^{2/}

7. AM & PM then asserts innocently that its "sole motivation" in filing its upgrade application was to improve its station's coverage. AM & PM Reply at 2.


8. We really don't know whether that's true or false. But we do know for sure that, irrespective of that "sole motivation", AM & PM was more than ready to abandon its oh-so-desirable upgrade plans before the ink was even dry on its construction permit in return for -- well, we (and the Commission) don't know what AM & PM stands to get out of that particular deal, because neither the Joint Parties nor AM & PM has deigned to let the Commission know. If AM & PM had been so dead-set on upgrading its Krum station -- as AM & PM seems to say in its Reply -- then when approached by the Joint Parties about

^{2/} In its Reply AM & PM does not seem to quarrel with that obvious conclusion. Rather, it merely asserts that it did not have "'advance' knowledge about the Quanah proceeding". AM & PM Reply at 2. It is one thing to have "knowledge" about future events, it is quite another to have some basis for suspicion about what events may be in the offing. And in any event, AM & PM's Reply does not include any declaration under penalty of perjury from any of AM & PM's principals to support any factual claims in its Reply.

abandoning that upgrade, AM & PM would have been expected to just say "no". That, of course, is not what AM & PM did, so its unsupported assertion of "sole motivation" is undermined by the well-established facts which have come to light.

9. In view of these circumstances, Elgin FM/Crawford stand by their Comments.
