





Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter is in regards to our E-rate application that was denied funding from the Schools and Libraries Division. I am a telecommunications consultant writing on behalf of the Quincy School District 172, Quincy, Illinois regarding the year 3 application for e-rate service that has been denied by the Schools and Libraries Division. We are respectfully appealing the denial of funding due to what I would consider an obscure quirk in the Schools and Libraries web site and inconsistent advice from two separate Schools and Libraries service reps.

Background – Quincy School District 172, 1444 Maine Street, Quincy, Illinois was denied service for year 3 funding year 7/1/2000 – 6/30/2001 per a letter dated July 26, 2001 (Attachment A) for 471 form application #212425.

The letter stated that the 471 application was submitted after the required date of July 15, 2000 and therefore rejected.

Original Problem – A brief statement of the events is needed to understand our problem and situation

1. Originally we tried unsuccessfully to submit a 470 form on line for year 3 for local service of \$80,335 or \$56,234.50 discount. Local service is guaranteed if it is within the submission window, so this should have easily been accepted.
2. We were not allowed to submit our 470 form online and the website stated that a 470 form is not required if the school district "has a contract signed on/before 7/10/97 and reported on a form 470 in a previous year as an existing contract do NOT require filing of a form 470". We have attached the 470 form and statement choices. The school's contract was from May 1996.

3. We terminated our submission of our 470 form on 11/20/99 well within the normal funding window. (Attachment B)

4. We called two service reps on or around the Schools and Libraries Division to verify that we did not have to submit a 470 form. They affirmed that no 470 form was required. It was my impression that this decision not to have a 470 form was to reduce paperwork (that we were in the system and it was automatic since we were approved successfully in years 1 and 2). The requirement not to have a 470 form was also a change from years 1 and 2 where it was required for multiple year contracts.

5. A 471 form was not submitted as it requires a 470 form which we were told not to submit and were not allowed on the website.

6. We followed up with the Schools and Libraries in September when a funding commitment letter was not provided to district from the Schools and Libraries.

7. We were told that a 471 form needed to be submitted for a commitment letter to be generated. When we asked how we could have submitted a 471 form without a 470 form the service rep checked and said that the previous years 470 form should have been used. Nowhere have I ever seen instructions to use the previous years 470 form. We asked what would be our next steps and we were told by two separate reps that funding probably would be tight but to submit a 471 form as soon as possible. In the past years 471 forms could be submitted anytime for funding without an arbitrary date. Nothing was mentioned about a 7/15/2000 due date and we were passed that date anyway.

8. We waited from September 2000 through this week 7/28/01 for a decision on our application for year 3.

Our Appeal – We are asking that the FCC assist in our appeal for full payment of the \$56,234.50 or even partial payment 50% or more due to several factors including a change in the 470 form that was not clear, help from the two Schools and Libraries service reps that was not complete (as to the need for a 471 form tied to a pre existing year 2 470 form and the importance of \$56,234.50 to a cash strapped school district to which this amount of money is significant).

Pertinents – Attached is our original 470 form that was stopped, our subsequent 471 form both which have application numbers and contact information.

Other Considerations – Quincy School District 172 is a poorer, rural school district that really needs assistance and relief on this. School District 172 is not the only school district that in good faith called for assistance and were not told that a 470 form for year 2 (the previous year) should be used.




