



REPLY TO COMMENTS ON RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION OF M&M BROADCASTERS, Ltd., AND INFORMAL OBJECTION TO KVCQ'S REQUEST FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT, FILE NUMBER BPH-20010124AJI

I, Maurice Salsa, hereby submit these "Reply to Comments on Response to Request for Supplemental Information of M&M Broadcasters, Ltd., and Informal Objection to KVCQ's Request for Construction Permit, File Number BPH-20010124AJI" in the above-captioned proceeding.

DISCUSSION

On May 10, 2002, M&M Broadcasters, Ltd. filed their Comments on "Response to Request for Supplemental Information". In those Comments, at #12, page 8, they stated:

"In the case of an application, simultaneous filing may be required, and the resulting construction permits may be appropriately conditioned to require that both facilities be completed prior to commencing operation with either. In the instant rule making context, however, there can be no such simultaneous action. The short-spaced allotment would need to be made and become effective before any party could file any application."

Similar circumstances apply to the KVCQ/ Cuero changes proposed in this Quanah proceeding. KVCQ is licensed to Cuero, has a grant for McQueeney, filed an application in January of 2001 for a construction permit to upgrade to McQueeney in addition to participating in a NPRM to abandon Cuero and to abandon McQueeney releasing it to go to Converse. Thus KVCQ seeks to maintain both the Cuero license and the McQueeney grant while petitioning to the FCC for approval to move still once again to a wholly new community of license and to preserve the contention that this request is not a withdrawal of an expression of interest for McQueeney.

A licensee that is filing for a construction permit for a grant as noted above cannot voluntarily choose to participate in an NPRM essentially causing the same type of actions to occur that is inconsistent with the construction permit application that they have requested to be granted. The KCVQ licensee, Rawhide Radio, L.L.C. ("Rawhide") has now caused to occur two applications to be filed with the Commission that are inconsistent with each other.


The KCVQ licensee, Rawhide, has to make a choice, either McQueeney or Converse. Rawhide's initial failure to withdraw their inconsistent participation in Quanah and of recent, their request for a construction permit to move to McQueeney effectively withdraws them from their participation in Quanah.

It is clear from past FCC policy, that licensees **may not** have pending applications and or construction permits and then enter into other agreements effectively "withdrawing an expression of interest". See Sections 73.3518 and 73.3520 which prohibit the filing of inconsistent or multiple applications.

The public interest is not served by the grant of the KVCQ construction permit to McQueeney, particularly if KVCQ has already committed to exit McQueeney and to relocate to Converse? By this letter I am officially opposing the grant of this construction permit for KVCQ.

The information provided in this "Reply to Comments on Response to Request for Supplemental Information of M&M Broadcasters, Ltd., and Informal Objection to KVCQ's Request for Construction Permit, File Number BPH-20010124AJI" is correct and true to the best of my knowledge.


