Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's rules, the undersigned, on behalf of Verizon Wireless ("Verizon"), hereby notifies the Commission of an oral presentation regarding the above-captioned matters. Specifically, on Tuesday, June 11, 2002, Charon J. Harris (Regulatory Counsel, Verizon Wireless), Kathryn A. Zachem (Wilkinson Barker Knauer, LLP) and the undersigned met with Matthew Brill (Common Carrier Legal Advisor) of Commissioner Abernathy's office to discuss issues raised in the above-referenced dockets.

In particular, reference was made to decisions in which the FCC recognized *quantum meruit* as creating a legal obligation for carriers or end users to pay for services received. Two decisions that we specifically discussed were *MCI Execunet*<sup>1</sup> and *ITT World Communications, Inc. v. Western Union Telegram*.<sup>2</sup>


