**Amendment to Petition for Limited Waiver of
Leaco Cellular, Inc. of
Sections 20.18(e) and (g) of the Commission’s Rules**

Leaco Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (“Leaco”), by its attorneys, hereby files this amendment to Leaco Cellular, Inc.’s (“Leaco Cellular”) September 20, 2001 petition for limited waiver of Sections 20.18(e) and (g) of the Commission’s Rules. The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the entity and licensed wireless systems to which the requested waiver applies.

Due to a series of *pro forma* license assignments to Leaco Cellular’s corporate parent, Leaco Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc., the petition should have been filed in the name of Leaco Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. rather than its subsidiary. Accordingly, Leaco requests that any relief granted pursuant to the waiver request be granted to Leaco Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. In addition, Leaco notes that the petition referenced only its cellular licenses, and seeks to clarify that its PCS licenses for the Hobbs Basic Trading Area (BTA 191) and Carlsbad Basic Trading Area (BTA 068) are also covered by the petition.
