**ALEE CELLULAR COMMUNICATIONS'**  
**INTERROGATORIES TO RANGER CELLULAR**

Alee Cellular Communications ("Alee") as provided for in §§1.311 and 1.323 of the Commission's Rules, submits the following interrogatories to Ranger Cellular ("Ranger").

**Instructions and Definitions**

The following definitions shall control in these interrogatories:

a. As used herein, the term "Ranger," "you," or "your" means Ranger Cellular, its principals, shareholders, employees, agents, consultants or other persons acting on its behalf.

b. The term "document" means handwritten, printed, typed, computerized or visually or aurally reproduced material of any kind, and means the original (or duplicate original) and any non-identical copies thereof (whether different from the original because of notes made on or attached to such copy or otherwise), drafts or amendments

thereof, including but not limited to, all writings, correspondence, memoranda (including memoranda or oral conversations), minutes, resolutions, agendas, notices, diaries, notes (including notes of meetings), papers, calendars, lists, records of telephone conversations, instructions, guidelines, affidavits, receipts, promissory notices, agreements, contracts or any other documentary materials of any nature whatsoever, including computer files, in your possession, custody, or control.

c. The term “identify” when used with reference to an entity other than a person, means to state its name, last known business address and last known business telephone number.

d. The term “identify” when used with reference to a person or persons, means to state his/her full name, last known business and residence addresses, and last known business and residence telephone numbers.

e. The term “identify” when used with reference to a document, means to state the date, author, addressee, type of document (*e.g.*, the types of documents referenced in definition b., above), a brief description of the subject matter, its present or last known location and its custodian. If any such document was, but no longer is in your possession or control, state the disposition that was made of it, the reason for such disposition, and the date thereof. In lieu of identifying any such document, it may be made available to Alee for inspection and copying by so stating in the answer.

f. If in answering these interrogatories you encounter any ambiguities construing a question, instruction or definition set forth the matter deemed ambiguous and the construction used in answering.

g. Where the knowledge of information in your possession is requested, such request includes knowledge in the possession of your agent, representative, and attorney.

h. References to the singular also include the plural and *vice versa*.

i. For each interrogatory or section response, indicate the number(s) of the interrogatory or section to which it is responsive.


### INTERROGATORIES

1. Identify Ranger's form of business organization, i.e., corporation, partnership, LLC.
2. Identify the state of incorporation or organization and the date of incorporation or organization.
3. Please provide your current principal business address.
4. Please identify all equity holders of Ranger.
5. If a corporation, identify Ranger's officers and directors. If a partnership, identify all of its current partners.
6. Does Ranger hold any FCC licenses? If so, identify by giving call sign, service and location of facilities.
7. Has Ranger held any FCC licenses in the past? If so, please identify by call sign, service, facility location and disposition (*i.e.*, sale or termination of license).
8. Identify all documents in your possession, other than those produced by Alee as part of the document production in this case, relevant to the issues specified in this case.
9. Identify any persons contacted by Ranger with knowledge concerning Alee's operation of its New Mexico 3 cellular facilities.
10. Is there any agreement with Miller Communications, Inc. in connection with its participation in the instant proceeding? If so, identify the agreement and describe its terms.

11. Identify the person(s) or document(s) relied upon by you in determining the substance of each of your answers.


