Gentlemen:

This letter is submitted on behalf of Microwave Radio Communications. In our meeting of June 18, 2002, a question arose about the additional costs of replacing 2 GHz BAS oscillators that have a 250 kHz step size with oscillators having a 125 kHz step size. This is our estimate of the costs:

Transmitters: \$1350 - \$1900 dependent on the radio model
Receivers: \$2400 - \$2800 dependent on the radio model

These costs are a reduction from our standard price for spare parts, and include installation.

These replacements are necessary for the FCC's 12.1 MHz channel plan, in all radios except for the Strata Series radios that have just begun to ship. These replacements would not be needed when modifying radios for a channel plan consisting of 14.5 MHz channels, or 12 MHz channels, or any other channel plan having center frequencies and offset channel frequencies that are a multiple of 250 kHz.
