





Dear Mr. Neely:

This is in response to your "Motion to Withdraw Expression of Interest" filed on behalf of AGM-Nevada, LLC (AGM-Nevada) on April 17, 2002. In that motion, you explain that AGM-Nevada is the new owner of Station KARS-FM, formerly Station KRQU(FM), Laramie, Wyoming, and that it wishes to withdraw the expression of interest filed by Laramie Mountain Broadcasting, L.L.C. (Laramie Mountain), the previous licensee of Station KRQU(FM), in a Petition for Rule Making to reallocate Station KRQU(FM), Channel 275C, from Laramie, Wyoming to LaPorte, Colorado and downgrade Channel 275C to Channel 275C2. That petition for rulemaking was returned as unacceptable for filing, but Laramie Mountain filed a "Petition for Reconsideration and Request for Acceptance of Rulemaking Petition Nunc Pro Tunc" on August 16, 2001.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 1.420(j) of the Commission's rules, you have provided a declaration under penalty of perjury from AGM Nevada stating that AGM Nevada does not desire to pursue the changes proposed for Station KARS-FM and that neither AGM Nevada nor any of its principals, have received or will receive, or paid or promised to pay any consideration in exchange for the dismissal of the petition for rule making.

In light of the foregoing, and on the basis of Commission policy which refrains from considering a rule making proposal absent a *bona fide* expression of interest, your request for withdrawal is granted and the rulemaking proposal to change the community of license of Station KARS-FM from Laramie, Wyoming, to LaPorte, Colorado, is dismissed.
