On June 26, 2002, Antoinette Cook Bush and Sophia Collier of Compass Systems, Inc. ("Compass") met with Commissioner Kathleen Abernathy and her senior legal advisor, Bryan Tramont. The Compass representatives encouraged the Commission to place Compass's direct broadcast satellite ("DBS") space station application on public notice. They noted that the Commission has accepted for filing SES Americom's petition for declaratory ruling even though the petition was filed subsequent to the Compass DBS application. In addition, the Compass representatives reviewed the arguments raised in Compass's Application for Review of the Commission's recent decision granting EchoStar a western DBS orbital slot, DA 02-1163.
