

Pursuant to the Public Notice released jointly by the Common Carrier Bureau and the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau on September 28, 2001, Verizon Wireless Puerto Rico ("VWPRTC") (TRS number 805932), a wireless carrier, hereby submits its supplement to its existing Section 107(c) petition to request an extension of the compliance date for the CALEA "punch list" electronic surveillance capability requirements. PRTC submits this Supplement to its existing Section 107(c) petition to request an extension of the compliance date set for punch-list capabilities as defined in Communications Assistance for Law Enforcement Act, *Order on Remand* (rel. April 11, 2002) until September 30, 2002. As the attached letter indicates, VWPR has been notified by its vendor, Ericsson, that the software installation necessary for VWPR to offer punch-list capabilities will not be complete until September 2002.

This letter is written in response to your request for information regarding the Ericsson CMS 8800 (D-AMPS) product for CALEA and CALEA Punch List implementation.

Ericsson hereby confirms that our Version 7.0 MSC software (does not include integrated HLR) is compliant with the J-STD-025 and J-STD-025A standards. The Version 7.0 software has been Generally Available since August 2001.

Also, Ericsson has made available a separate delivery function using the Verint Star-Gate product to provide information to Law Enforcement Agencies compliant with the J-STD-025 and J-STD-025A standards. The Verint Star-Gate product (or other comparable 3rd party device) is required for the Ericsson CMS 8800 (D-AMPS) platform to deliver information to law enforcement in accordance with the J-STD-025 and J-STD-025A.

The current Verint Star-Gate is operating with software load 7.3, which is J-STD 025 compliant. The Verint Star-Gate for J-STD-25A is planned to be available with software load 7.9 during September 2002 pending completion of Test & Verification.
