REPLY COMMENTS OF VERMONT ETV, INC.

Vermont ETV, Inc. ("VETV") is the licensee of four noncommercial education television stations in Vermont -- WETK (Burlington, VT), WVER (Rutland, VT), WVTB (St. Johnsbury, VT), WVTA (Windsor, VT). VETV joins with Mt. Mansfield Television, Inc. ("Mt. Mansfield") in urging the Commission to devote attention to delays resulting from the need to obtain concurrence from the Canadian government for changes in the DTV channels or other allotment parameters of television stations near the Canadian border. As noted in Mt. Mansfield's Comments in the above-captioned proceeding, the Commission's Letter of Understanding with Canada ("LOU")<sup>1</sup> contains no time table for resolving disputes if the Canadian government objects to a change of a DTV allotment. This presents the possibility of indefinite delays for stations such as VETV's that may need to alter their allotment parameters.

Coordination issues with Canada present serious issues for all stations operating within 400 kilometers of the Canadian border that may seek to enhance the service provided to




