By the Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. The Telecommunications Access Policy Division (Division) has under consideration the above-captioned Requests for Review.<sup>1</sup> The above-captioned entities seek review of a decision of the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Company (Administrator), denying their request for discounted services.<sup>2</sup> On April 22, 2002, the above-captioned entities filed Requests to Withdraw their Requests for Review.<sup>3</sup> The


