

Counsel for the parties have worked out differences with respect to the place for taking five Alaska Depositions. It was reported in a conference telephone call on June 25, 2002, that the parties have agreed that counsel for the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") will take the depositions in Alaska in accordance with issued and outstanding Notices of Depositions. The depositions will be taken during the week of August 13, 2002.¹

Counsel for Peninsula Communications, Inc. ("PCI") has elected to participate in the depositions by phone, or in person, at PCI's option.

With regard to other outstanding discovery, PCI's Supplemental Answers to the Bureau's Interrogatories may be filed with the Commission on July 5, 2002. But the supplemental information will be faxed or e-mailed to Bureau counsel by June 28, 2002 as previously ordered. See Memorandum Opinion and Order, FCC 02M-55, released June 25, 2002.²
