

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 10, 2002, Richard Metzger and I, counsel to Spectrum Communications Cabling Services, Inc., met with Mark Seifert, Narda Jones, Jonathan Secrest, Ruth Yodaiken and Romanda Williams of the Telecommunications Access Policy Division of the FCC's Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. During these discussions we reiterated Spectrum's view that the Commission's proposed online eligible services list should be flexible enough to allow applicants to obtain innovative products and services that may not be included on the list. We also discussed steps the Commission might take to rectify the competitive imbalance caused by the current rules governing the leasing of internal connection equipment that is bundled with telecommunications and Internet access services. In addition, we discussed the Commission's proposals to limit transfers of equipment.

Consistent with the Commission's rules, this letter is being provided to you for inclusion in the public record of the above-referenced proceeding.
