Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules, I am filing this letter electronically to report oral *ex parte* communications in the above-referenced proceeding.

On July 11 and 12, 2002, on behalf of Uniden America Corp., I had oral telephone conversations with Alan J. Scrimme of the Office of Engineering and Technology, Sam Feder, of Commissioner Kevin Martin's office, and Bryan Tramont, of Commissioner Kathleen Q. Abernathy's office. Also, Ashley O. Thrift of this Firm and I had oral telephone conversations with Commissioner Michael Copps and his adviser, Paul Margie.

In the conversations, we discussed potential dates for shifting radar detector manufacturing to new models with different frequency attributes. We suggested that a manufacturing transition date before December 1, 2002 would be of extreme prejudice to certain members of the radar detector manufacturing community vis-à-vis others. Further, we proposed that any labeling requirement would send signals to the consuming public that would make alleged radar detector problems worse, rather than better.

Today, either Mr. Thrift or I had follow-up discussions with Mr. Scrimme and Paul Margie of Commissioner Copps' office.
