I understand that the radar detector item is close to release. In keeping with the concerns we expressed last week, it would be helpful if the Order were to make clear that there is a potential for interference to satellite bands other than 11.7-12.2 GHz, and that the Commission is open to examining the "other band" interference issue at a later stage of the proceeding. You may be seeing proposed language to that effect from one of the other Commissioner's offices.
