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

**MOTION TO DISMISS COUNTERPROPOSAL
OF CAMERON BROADCASTING, INC.**

KJUL License, LLC ("License"), license of KSTJ(FM), Boulder City, Nevada, hereby moves to dismiss the Counterproposal filed by Cameron Broadcasting, Inc. in the above-captioned matter. License initially provisionally consented to the proposed downgrading of Channel 247C to 247CO based on certain conditions being satisfied. One of the conditions of License's consent has not been satisfied, and accordingly License hereby notifies the Commission that it has withdrawn its conditional consent to the proposed downgrade. The Commission has stated it will not downgrade a station to accommodate the desire of another station to change its facilities unless the affected station consents. See Columbia City, Florida, 14 FCC Rcd 21165 (1999); Flora and Kings, Mississippi, and Newellton, Louisiana, 7 FCC Rcd

5477 (1992). Since License does not consent to the proposed downgrade, the Counterproposal must be dismissed.

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
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
