Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 24, 2002, Killen Broadcasting Company ("KBC") tendered a "Petition for Rulemaking" proposing the allotment of FM Channel 265A at Killen, Alabama, ("Petition").

At the time of filing, KBC was unaware that that same day, the licensee of FM broadcast station WYDE-FM, Cullman, Alabama, voluntarily dismissed with prejudice its application for a minor modification of construction permit (File No. BMPH-20011206AAD). According to the FCC database, the Commission will give public notice of this dismissal on July 29, 2002. The dismissal of that WYDE-FM application precludes the acceptance of the KBC Petition. Accordingly, KBC herewith voluntarily dismisses its Petition and requests that it be returned to KBC.
