On Tuesday July 30, 2002, Fraser Jennings and Ken Wykle of Savi Technology, Gene Robinson of EA Robinson Consulting, Robert Pettit of Wiley Rein & Fielding LLP and the undersigned met with Commission, NTIA and Department of Defense staff to discuss the above referenced docket. Government attendees present were: Fred Thomas and Hugh Van Tuyl of the Office of Engineering and Technology representing the FCC; Michael Doolan and Gerald Hurt representing NTIA; Nelson Pollack and Tom Ahn representing the Air Force; Joe Capps representing the Army; Raymond Willis representing the Navy; and Badri Younes representing the Department of Defense.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss sharing studies developed by Savi, NTIA and the Department of Defense. Additionally, concerns of Savi and the Department of Defense were discussed concerning the current FCC proposed rule making. Savi reiterated its position, already reflected in the docket, that the Savi proposal would create no harmful interference to government systems.
