On July 25, 2002, Michael Petricone, Vice President, Technology Policy, Consumer Electronics Association ("CEA") and David Siddall, of Paul, Hastings, Janofsky & Walker, met with Catherine Bohigian, legal advisor to Commissioner Kevin Martin.
