Art has long held a starring role in the quality of life of communities. In 1989, a group of people seeking to enhance their community formed the Shoreline Arts Council to support, present and encourage the arts in Lake Forest Park and Shoreline. This non-profit, community-based organization enriches the life of every resident by not only promoting public awareness of the arts, but by making art available in all its forms.

As the primary arts presenter and sponsor, the Council continues to bring a wide variety of art experiences to Shoreline and Lake Forest Park with performances, exhibitions and programs.

Performance series such as Arts in Culture, the Children's Saturday Series and summer Concerts in the Parks deliver quality music, dance and theater to the local community.

Each year, the Shoreline Arts Festival brings all the arts together to a central location with creative energy and life. The celebration offers a feast for the senses and invites the community to become part of the arts with hands-on activities. Almost every art form is represented from music, dance and theater to sculpture, crafts, food and poetry.

The Arts Council supports Artists-in-Residence in the schools, facilitates Metro Bus Shelter Murals to visually enhance neighborhoods, and supports local cultural organizations such as the Shoreline Community Band, Choir of the Sound, Upstage Theatre and Filipiniana. The Council also collaborates with other agencies such as the libraries, the Community College, Senior Center and the Cities of Lake Forest Park and Shoreline to ensure a wealth of quality arts experiences throughout the year.

Shoreline Arts, a quarterly newsletter, informs patrons and artists about the latest Shoreline Arts Council happenings. All programs provided by the council are wheelchair accessible, and most are free thanks to support from the Cities of Lake Forest Park and Shoreline, King County, the Washington State Arts Commission and Shoreline Arts Council Friends of the Arts.
