


Dear Ms. Crawford:

This is in response to the Petition for Rule Making that you filed requesting the allotment of Channel 284C at Helper, Utah, as that community's first aural broadcast service.

Your request for the allotment of Channel 284C at Helper, Utah, is unacceptable. Our engineering analysis indicates that the site that you specify in your proposal (39-34-44 NL and 110-35-49 WL) is short-spaced to Station KMXU (Channel 286C) at Manti, Utah (coordinates 39-45-37 NL and 111-34-38 WL). Our analysis further shows that, using Helper center city coordinates (39-41-03 NL and 110-51-14 WL), Channel 284C cannot be site-restricted to provide the required city grade coverage to Helper while affording the required protection to surrounding FM stations.

Based on the above, we are returning your proposal for Helper. You may resubmit the petition, provided that you make a showing that a fully-spaced transmitter site is available that provides city grade coverage to the entire community.

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 284C at Helper, Utah.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 284C to Helper, Utah, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Helper is an incorporated city with a population of over 2,200 people. Helper has its own mayor, Mike R. Dalpiaz, its own post office, its own school system, its own fire department, its own city hall and a number of local churches.


