On August 7, 2002, representatives of RadioShack and I met by phone with Paul Margie, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Copps. Today, Larry Harris, Vice President of Merchandising at RadioShack, Dwayne Campbell, Director of Product Compliance and Evaluation at RadioShack, and I met in person with the following Commission officials: Peter Tenhula, Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Powell, Bryan Tramont, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Abernathy, Sam Feder, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Martin and Alan Scrimme, Chief of OET's Policy and Rules Division, Bruce Romano, Karen Rackley, Ira Keltz, and Hugh Van Tuyl also with OET.

The purpose of these meetings was to raise concerns relating to the compliance timeframe established in the Commission's Order to extend Part 15 to radar detectors. The presentation focused particularly on the effects of the compliance timeframes on RadioShack's distribution process. We also discussed methods by which RadioShack's concerns could be addressed under the Commission's rules and how RadioShack's concerns affect RADAR's pending Petition for Partial Reconsideration.
