Proponents original petition.


DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be  
Served by allocating Channel 227C3 to Matador, Texas.  
Matador, Texas is an incorporated community of 673 people as of  
January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center.  
Matador is also the county seat of Motley County. Matador has its  
own mayor, Rodney Williams, its own post office, its own fire  
department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number  
of local churches. The proposed channel 227C3 will provide  
additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to  
Matador residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Should this petition be granted, and Channel 227C3 be allotted to Matador, Texas Petitioner will apply for Channel 227C3, and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.
