I am against the suggestions submitted in RM-10521. The proximity of the European Personal Mobile Radio frequencies to the amateur 70cm 446.0 mc call frequency will most certainly cause interference to this ham band. The argument that the existing Part 97 Amateur Service rules precluding the use of PMR 446 radios in the US: "are essentially unenforceable", is to assume that all people are law breakers and will therefore break any law that is not enforceable. In my case, as well as many other people, I obey the law whether it is enforceable or not.
