

I oppose RM-10521 for three reasons:

1. There is no requirement for FRS users to identify themselves. Therefore, its not possible to tell if the user is a foreign national or a US citizen using part 15 radios illegally.
2. Communications between amateurs and unlicensed entities is illegal. Having unlicensed individuals on the same frequencies as amateurs would put amateurs, possibly unknowingly, in violation of this rule by communicating with FRS users.
3. Having unlicensed users on the US amateur bands is contrary to the basis and purpose of amateur radio.

For these reasons I respectfully request the commission DENY petition RM-10521.
