**Dear Ms. Dortch:**

**On August 8, 2002, the undersigned and Don Petry, representing Hewlett-Packard (“HP”), met by telephone conference with Jon Minkoff and Michael Carowitz of the FCC’s Wireline Competition Bureau to respond to a follow-up clarifying question regarding HP’s 8/6/02 ex parte letter filed in WC Docket 02-148 (also filed in the above-captioned docket 8/19/02) concerning pre-order to order integration and parsing.**

**The clarification was in regards to HP's ex parte statements on Pre-Order/Order integration for Qwest IMA EDI Release 8.0. The following is a summary of HP’s answer:**

HP certified on Qwest's IMA EDI Release 8.0 for execution of the ROC Master Test Plan - Test 15 - POP Volume Performance Test. This test was performed using mechanized scripts rather than P-CLEC Customer Service Representatives performing data entry of test transactions.

HP performed an analysis of Qwest's IMA EDI Release 8.0 Disclosure documentation and reported their findings in the HP Pre-Order/Order Integration Field Comparison Report - Analysis of Qwest IMA EDI Release 8.0. However, HP did not implement pre-order to pre-order and pre-order to order integration into the software environment used for the Test 15-POP

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Volume Performance Test. Accordingly, the Pre-Order/Order Integration Field Comparison Report - Analysis of Qwest IMA EDI Release 8.0 does not contain a P-CLEC Data Integration section.

Additionally, while HP did not produce an appendix in their final report on this topic, HP also developed and implemented the following functionality based upon publicly available Qwest IMA EDI Release 6.0 documentation:

- Pre-Order response to Pre-Order query integration for address related data
- Pre-Order response to Order integration for address related data
- Customer Service Record (CSR) to Order integration for Resale POTS & UNE-P POTS
