Jim,

... As previously discussed, SBC will be filing wholesale tariffs or negotiating interconnection agreement amendments in all 13 SBC states and retail (PSAP) tariffs in 11 of the 13 states that will cover Phases I and II of Wireless 9-1-1. SBC plans on having Phase II functionality generally available in our 9-1-1 platforms and 9-1-1 Selective Routers by October 31, 2002. However, the October 31 date could be extended if there is no approved/effective retail tariff in a respective state.

Considering the above, I do not believe a face-to-face meeting would be necessary or productive at this time.

E911 PHASE II TIMELINE

VZW Work

VZW network upgrades:
Load AGPS/AFLT software in switches and cell sites. Completed in all Lucent and Nortel switched markets (80% of footprint).

Test Phase II interface with LEC, site surveys, calibration of tower site coordinates, accuracy testing.

Interoperability testing (VZW, LEC, PSAP)

LEC/PSAP Work

LEC ALI Database Upgrades: Select Phase II format (e.g., E2+, enhanced PAM) contract with PSAP, and perform upgrades.

Modify ALI data format for delivery of data to PSAP and display.

Modify PSAP CPE for PSAP to be able to rebid ALI database.

Modify PSAP CPE screen display to show Phase II data, modify mapping capability.

All parties must be ready to participate in interoperability testing at this point in order to go live.
