Dear Ms. Dortch:

Qwest Communications International Inc. ("Qwest"), by its attorneys, hereby advises the Commission that Qwest recently discovered that, in its Reply Comments filed July 29, 2002, Qwest inadvertently filed Reply Exhibit CLD-28 (ASCII and Paper Format Comparison) without redacting confidential portions of that document.

Qwest typically redacts account and telephone number information from documents it submits to the Commission. In this case, portions of pages six through 17 of Reply Exhibit CLD-28 were not redacted to remove this information. Qwest therefore respectfully requests that pages six through 17 of Reply Exhibit CLD-28 be treated by the Commission and the parties to this proceeding as confidential and subject to the Protective Order. To the extent a party has not executed the Protective Order and is in possession of Reply Exhibit CLD-28, Qwest respectfully requests that the party destroy it and replace it with the attached redacted version.

To Qwest's knowledge, no party has suffered material harm from this inadvertent error. Qwest therefore is making this filing out of an abundance of caution and to ensure that the record in this proceeding is clear.

Qwest also writes to advise the Commission of a change to its June 2002 Commercial Performance Results for PID B1-3A in Nebraska. Qwest erroneously omitted some data when it first reported the results, which made it appear as if Qwest had missed the parity standard. With the inclusion of the omitted records, Qwest met the parity standard in Nebraska in June for BI-3A, which further confirms that Qwest is providing CLECS with complete bills. Revised results for June under BI-3A in Nebraska were reported in the July 2002 reports.
