Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Rules, on behalf of respondent Anne Arundel County, Maryland, this summarizes meetings of September 4, 2002 with Commissioner Copps and Paul Margie, and with Commissioner Abernathy and Bryan Tramont, that included County Attorney Linda Schuett, Communications Director Jay Cuccia, Police Chief Thomas Shanahan, Fire Chief Roger Simonds and the undersigned.

We discussed summaries of the proceeding and the County's views which were previously placed on the record of WT 02-100 by the LSGAC and which are available on the Electronic Comment Filing System. (Dated 8/1/02; posted 8/5/02) The discussion was amplified by a color map of the 61 "dead zones" referenced in the record and an updating of their status in mitigation. The color map will be submitted separately when it becomes available in quantity. The chronology of events represented in the record summaries was augmented by several new dates recited from memory by County representatives. The summaries will be refiled when the dates can be checked and confirmed.
