Dear Ms. Dortch:

Verizon is filing this Erratum to correct the June C2C Performance Reports that were provided in its initial application filed on August 1, 2002. Those reports, inadvertently, were generated using the statistical methodologies in the version of Appendix K to the Guidelines that does not take effect in Virginia until September 2002, which is the same version of Appendix K that was adopted by the New York PSC in April 2002.

Accordingly, attached are revised Summary Measurement and CLEC Aggregate Reports for June 2002, calculated using the statistical methodologies in the version of Appendix K that is currently in effect in Virginia, which is the same version adopted by the New York PSC in October 2001. These reports replace those previously included in Verizon's initial application at Appendix Q, Tabs 2 and 4; respectively. Since Verizon is also filing its July C2C Trend Report today, which includes the revised June data, a revised June C2C Trend Report is not included with this Erratum.

Please let me know if you have any questions. The twenty-page limit does not apply as set forth in DA 02-1857.
