On September 19, 2002, Harold Feld, Associate Director, MAP, spoke with Alex Johns, Mass Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps.

Mr. Feld stressed that the motion recently filed by MAP on behalf of Petitioners CFA, *et al.* to request the Commission compel AT&T and Comcast to submit the High Speed Internet Access agreement concluded with AOL Time Warner as part of the TWE Divestiture agreement is addressed to the Commission. Furthermore, it is the responsibility of the Commission to consider whether the record is complete or if further information is required. Accordingly, the Commission should not simply delegate the decision on the motion to staff.
