Re: Amendment to Application for Consent to Assignment of Blanket Authority
from CoServ, LLC (Debtor-in-Possession) to CFC Telecom Holdings, LLC

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 5, 2002, CoServ, LLC (Debtor-in-Possession) ("CoServ") and CFC Telecom Holdings, LLC ("Telecom Holdings") filed an application for FCC consent to the assignment of CoServ's blanket authority to provide domestic telecommunications services. By this letter, in response to a request from Commission staff, Telecom Holdings supplements the application to specify:

1. The application is subject to streamlined processing under Section 63.03(b)(1)(iii) of the Commission's rules, as the application requests consent to assign local exchange assets of an incumbent LEC, CoServ. No transfer of corporate control is contemplated.
2. The transaction contemplates the assignment of all telecom-related assets to Telecom Holdings, a subsidiary of CoServ's largest creditor.

We trust this is responsive to staff's inquiry.
